

SCHEDULE OF FEES

AGISTMENT

- \$220¹ / week to include
- Morning & evening hard feed²; hay at lunch³
 - Rugging (max 3 rugs)
 - Daily turnout; mucking out
- Additional costs
- A regular worming program that includes all horses. Worm paste is on-billed in monthly agistment invoice
 - Night accommodation may be in either stable or paddock depending on your choice & availability. If in stable, shavings used are on-billed at cost
 - Fee for management and treatment of ongoing medical matters. To be charged in ten minute blocks at \$5 / ten minutes. This will *not* apply to one off situations, colic etc.
- A weekly retainer fee will apply should the horse be spelled off-site:
- \$50/wk for the first 2 weeks p/annum
 - 50% agistment fee thereafter

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

BOOKINGS & CANCELLATIONS

- Regular bookings
- Currently taken on a weekly basis. Bookings are rolled over each week/fortnight unless discussed/ advised to the contrary.
- 'Ad hoc' bookings
- Can be organised as/if required providing there is horse/instructor availability. Once a booking is made we charge 50% of usual fee if the lesson is cancelled with more than 24 hours but less than 7 days notice. If cancelled with less than 24 hours (or 'no show') full lesson fee is charged.
- Insurance cover
- We recommend riders are members of Equestrian Australia (EA). All riders must sign a waiver prior to their first lesson.
- Wet weather
- We are generally happy to continue teaching in bad/wet weather. In extreme conditions stable management can be taught.
